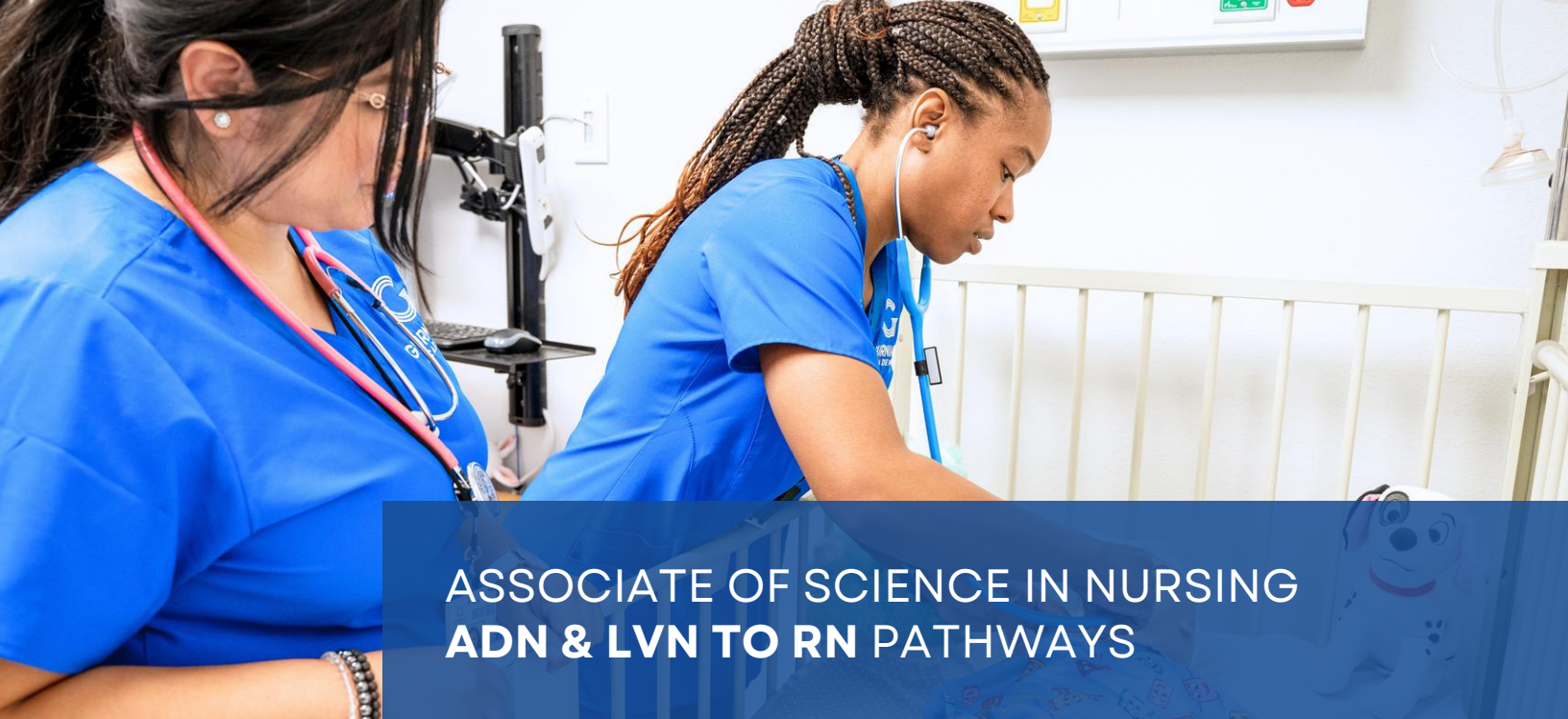

**The Associate of Science in Nursing (ADN & LVN to RN) Program** provides academic lectures, laboratory training, and clinical rotations correlating with theoretical knowledge.

**The Program curriculum** provides students with the technical, clinical, and interpersonal skills necessary to succeed in this field. Subjects covered include General Education Courses, Maternal & Newborn, Pediatrics, Gerontology, Mental Health Nursing, and Comprehensive Medical-Surgical Nursing.

**Campuses** conduct courses in classrooms equipped with audiovisual teaching aids, anatomical charts, and models.

**Our Simulation Learning Center (SLC)** is designed to look like a hospital. **Each bay in the center represents a hospital unit** such as a labor & delivery suite, pediatric suite, and med-surg unit. This allows students to practice core concepts of the nursing process and **gain hands-on** experience treating various patients and conditions **before immersing themselves in the acute care setting** for their clinical hours.
