36-hour course includes didactic sessions and a clinical practicum

The course spans two consecutive weekends, featuring three nine-hour days of didactic training focused on the theory and principles of intravenous therapy and blood withdrawal. Additionally, participants will complete a nine-hour clinical practicum in a clinical skills lab setting.

Get ready to sharpen your skills! Students will have the opportunity to perform at least three individually supervised successful venipunctures and three skin punctures (capillary blood withdrawals) on live human subjects—hands-on learning at its best!

Participants must bring a volunteer to participate in the venipuncture skills check to complete the course's clinical portion on the final day.
